The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) updated the CDC Grant Funding Profiles for fiscal year 2023 (FY23) in the following ways:

- The FY23 funding data and profiles have been added
- Funding categories and subcategories are based primarily on CDC's and the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry's [FY23 Operating Plans](#). Additional funding categories and subcategories are included for domestic-focused funds transferred from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to CDC from the Public Health and Social Services Emergency Fund (PHSSEF) and for the Drug Free Communities program. The data also includes funding provided through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law No: 117-2), whether provided to CDC directly or through transfers from HHS.
- All documentation for the profiles, such as "About the Data," has been updated as needed.
